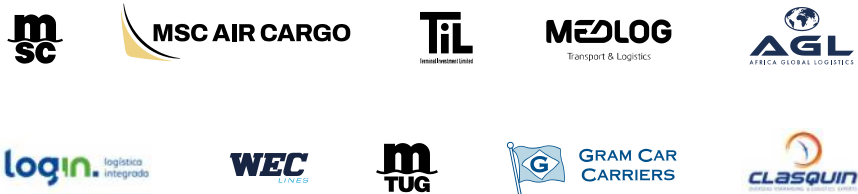

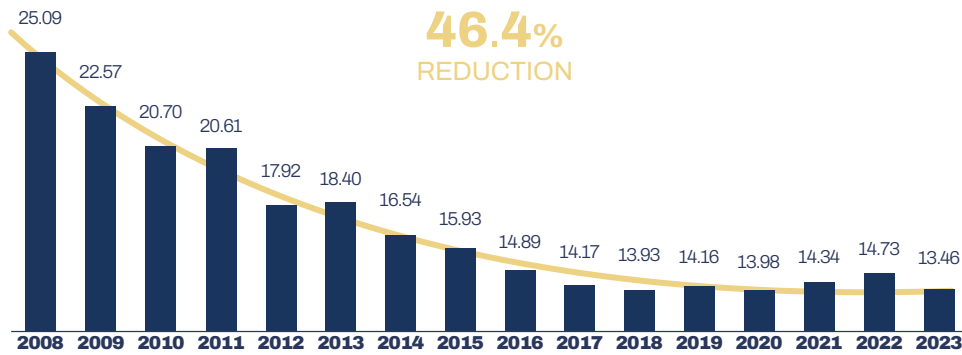
We maintain a firm position to avoid trade routes in vulnerable areas such as the Northern Sea Route.

MSC'S JOURNEY TO NET ZERO: REDUCING THE CARBON INTENSITY OF OUR FLEET

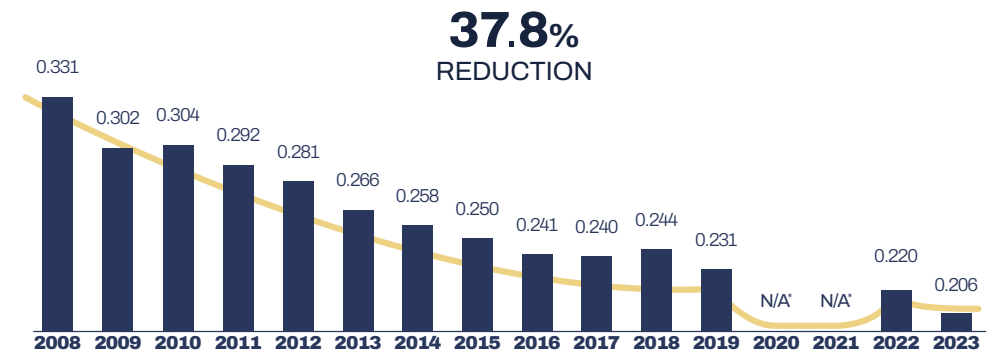
CARBON INTENSITY: MSC CONTAINER FLEET

Founded by Captain Gianluigi Aponte, MSC Mediterranean Shipping Company (MSC) has been headquartered in Geneva, Switzerland, since 1978. As world leader, MSC provides timely delivery of goods and services to local communities, customers and international business partners across five continents. The Company's international headquarters supervise a worldwide network of offices with each having responsibility for commercial and operational activities in their respective countries.

MSC was crowned "Shipping Company of the Year" at the Seatrade Maritime Awards 2023. This prestigious accolade recognized MSC for its outstanding response in keeping

worldwide trade moving amid global and industry challenges, the Company's commitment and achievements in supply chain decarbonization, and its significant role in leading digitalization for the industry in the past year.

The world experienced a global economic downturn and ongoing industry challenges including exceptional market conditions, operational constraints and consequential impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. Despite such unprecedented times, MSC continued to maintain a strong position across its cargo business, minimized disruptions to clients' supply chains and optimized their customer experience.

ADVANCING THE INDUSTRY THROUGH DIGITALIZATION AND SUSTAINABILITY

On the digitalization front, as a founding member of the Digital Container Shipping Association (DCSA), in February 2023 MSC committed to transitioning to committed to transition to 100% use of electronic Bills of Lading (eBLs) by 2030. This milestone represents a significant step forward for MSC, its customers and the industry. Meanwhile, in line with its commitment to net-zero decarbonization of its fleet by 2050, MSC prepared a range of robust measures to ensure compliance with the latest IMO regulations. This includes a new voyage optimization programme rolled out earlier this year, pursuing a range of alternative fuel solutions as well as modernizing its fleet through the industry-leading new building programme.

Over the years, MSC has invested in several initiatives and has further diversified its business-related activities. The Company has seen exponential growth in terms of both volume and fleet capacity, and now serves millions of customers globally, with a 365-days-a-year operation.

Today, our focus remains true to our roots, building and retaining long-term trusted partnerships with customers of all size and scale.

A MODERN, EFFICIENT FLEET

MSC Tessa (built 2023), 24 116 TEUs, and MSC Venice (built 2016), 16 652 TEUs

MSC operates one of the youngest fleets in the world, including some of the world's most low-carbon footprint vessels available today.

Our ultra large vessels (Gülsün Class and Celestino Maresca Class) help us in achieving economies of scale, resulting in lower carbon emissions per container carried. MSC launched its new record-breaking 24,000+ TEU Celestino Maresca class vessels in July 2023 – the biggest and most fuel-efficient containerships by design.

In recent years, MSC has made investments in LNG-fuelled vessels. In 2022, MSC saw its first four newbuilding dual-fuel LNG-capable container vessels in operation. MSC is committed to maintaining a modern fleet that will advance progress towards net-zero decarbonization by replacing conventional fuel vessels with dual-fuel capable vessels in the short term, including those fuelled by LNG.

In addition to our substantial investment in new and technologically advanced vessels, we continue an extensive retrofit programme and other measures to achieve optimal efficiency. We also actively explore a range of alternative fuels and propulsion solutions that will help the business move even closer towards net-zero, and we see cross-industry collaboration as crucial to scaling these solutions for the maritime industry.

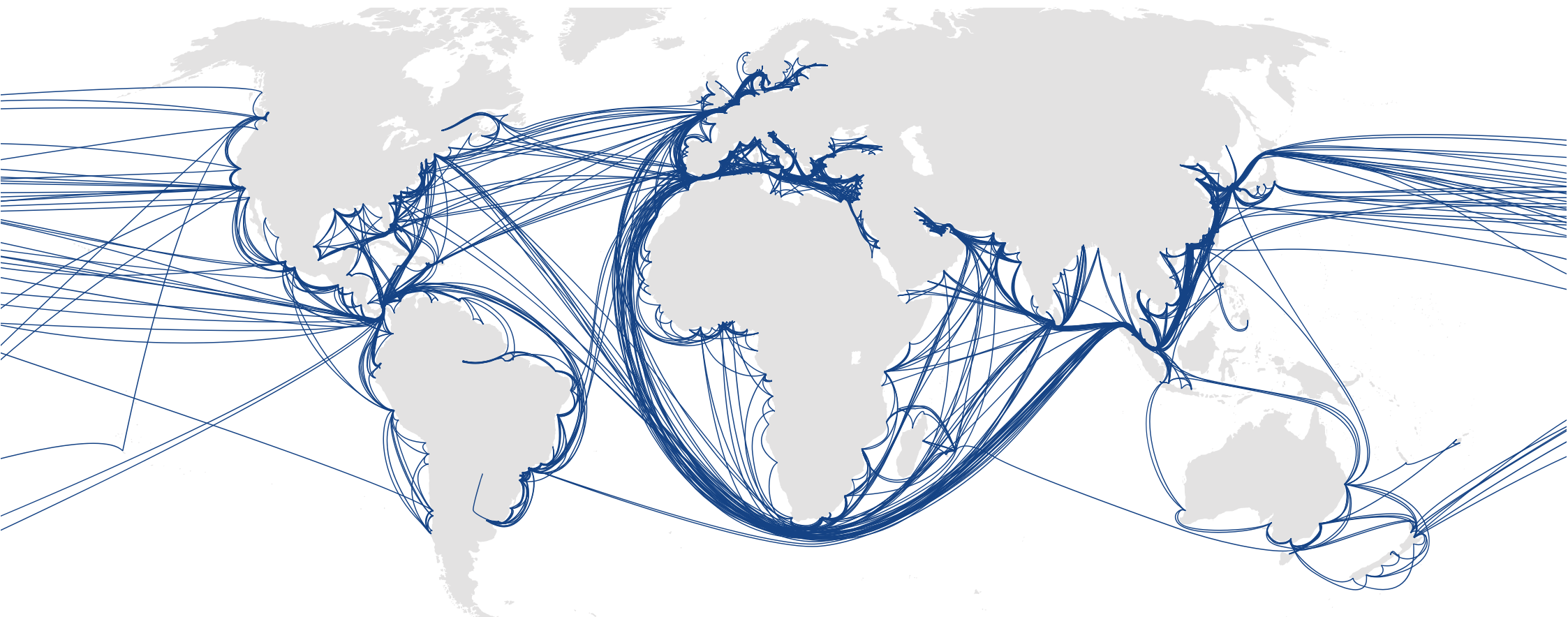

MSC SHIPMANAGEMENT

The technical management of MSC's vessels and crew management are handled by MSC Shipmanagement technical offices, respectively located in Limassol, Cyprus and Sorrento, Italy. The technical management of the ship includes the procurement of stores and spare parts, vessel maintenance, daily monitoring of vessel performance in terms of fuel efficiency, vessel condition assessment and upgrade, dry-dockings and retrofit projects, classification and regulatory compliance, assistance on insurance cases, optimization of new and existing vessels design for cargo handling, research and new building vessels supervision, research, design and construction.

The Company also manages crew training centres in India, Ukraine, Italy and Montenegro.

MSC Shipmanagement is one of the few companies whose entire operated fleet and shore office is accredited with ISO 9001 (Quality management), ISO 14001 (Environment management certification), ISO 50001 (Energy management system certification), ISO 27001 (Information security management system) and ISO 45001 (Occupational health & safety management standard).

TiL ranks among the world's largest and most geographically diverse container terminal operators. Over the past 15 years, our average annual throughput growth rate has exceeded 9%, significantly outpacing the industry average of approximately 4%.

Active in 31 countries across five continents, with highly strategic assets located in key gateways for global trade, TiL is present at 9 of the world's 30 busiest ports by volume: Singapore, Ningbo, Busan, Rotterdam, Antwerp, Los Angeles, Long Beach, Newark (New York–New Jersey) and Valencia.*

TiL continuously invests in terminals worldwide, focusing on highly strategic assets in key global trade gateways. We also commit to greenfield developments, having established significant container terminals in the Port of Santos (Brazil) and the Port of Lomé (Togo). Currently, TiL is developing multiple large-scale projects, including a new 2M TEUs container terminal in the Port of Baltimore. This terminal will enhance critical handling capacity, serving the Washington–Baltimore hinterland and acting as a key gateway for intermodal transport to the US Midwest.

SNAV is an Italian company which operates ferry services in Italy and Croatia. The company includes a number of high-speed modern crafts, creating fast attractive route options within Italy, in the Gulf of Naples (Capri, Ischia, Procida, Castellammare and Sorrento), Aeolian Islands (Stromboli, Panarea, Salina, Lipari and Vulcano) and Pontine Islands (Ponza and Ventotene).

The second ferry, SNAV Polaris, is currently under construction and is expected to be delivered in May 2025.

The Italo fleet comprises 25 cutting-edge AGV 575 trains and 26 Italo EVO trains. Both trains can travel at very high speeds, with the AGV 575 travelling up to 300 km/h and the EVO reaching a maximum speed of 250 km/h. All trains comply with the latest safety standard requirements. The Italo network connects 62 stations and 59 cities with 51 trains in a total of 118 daily trips; this broad coverage efficiently connects major Italian destinations from North to South.

A MODERN, REGULAR BUS FLEET

In May 2023, Italo enhanced its portfolio and acquired Itabus, a private long-distance coach company. Itabus offers intermodal services, including train and bus connections that link large cities, small towns and infrastructure hubs across Italy. With a fleet of 100 latest-generation MAN vehicles, Itabus provides integrated mobility services, offering 2,200 daily connections and 500 daily departures from more than 85 Italian cities. The Itabus fleet offers a superior quality service with double-decker buses (74 seats each) and two travel styles (Comfort+ or Top) and vehicles equipped with free 4G or 5G WI-FI, toilets, and on-board vending machines.

SUSTAINABLE FOCUS

Since its foundation, Italo has made sustainability a core operating principle. The company has a strong innovative spirit and is known for its environmentally-friendly transportation; the trains are currently built with 98% recyclable materials. Italo also actively works to manage resources based on a circular economy approach.

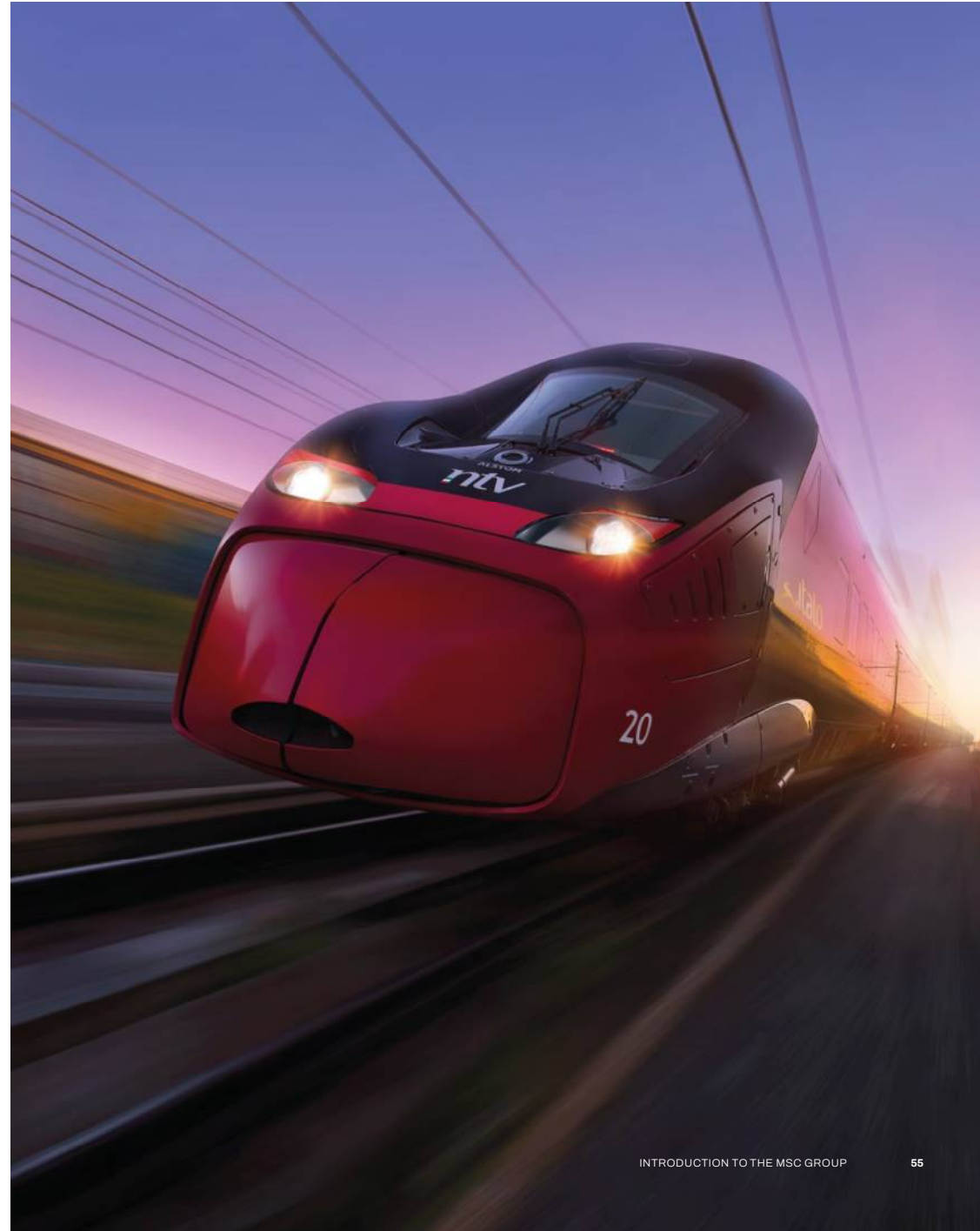

In 2022 the company achieved first place among national transport companies in the Financial Times' Diversity and Inclusion Survey (with 50% of posts held by women, even in roles traditionally held by men). Ranking best-in-class for safety since 2015, Italo installed two defibrillators on every train in the fleet, and on-board staff are trained in first-aid response. In a world-first initiative towards health and well-being, in 2021 Italo became the first railway operator to install HEPA air filters, demonstrating a 50 million euro investment in traveller and employee safety.

Executive Club elevates the travel experience with a more exclusive ambience and bespoke services, perfect for discerning clients accustomed to luxury. Italo guarantees complimentary WI-FI access on board to all passengers. Through the Italo Live portal, passengers can enjoy a range of complimentary entertainment options including movies, newspapers, digital books, music and games. For added convenience, the Cinema carriage features a selection of the best movies of the month for passengers to enjoy during their journey.

SUPER CORAL REEFS PROGRAMME

OCEAN CAY, THE BAHAMAS



The MSC Foundation is collaborating with a panel of internationally renowned scientists and conservation experts to protect, restore, and nurture 64 square miles of marine waters and ecosystems around Ocean Cay island in the Bahamas. Here, the Super Coral Reefs Programme is advancing coral reef conservation and restoration techniques to address the impacts of climate change and share these methods globally. This work will be supported by the Marine Conservation Center, currently under construction and set to open in April 2025.

PLASTIC WASTE GOES TO SCHOOL

CÔTE D'IVOIRE

PARTNER: UNICEF



Since 2009, we have partnered with UNICEF in life-changing programmes to fight malaria in Africa, to provide education for children living in the slums of Brazil and to combat child malnutrition, saving 100,000 young lives. Our most recent programme together is "From Plastic Bricks to Classrooms" in Côte d'Ivoire, where we're recycling plastic waste to build modern classrooms and support children's education, while enhancing the livelihoods of women waste collectors by improving their pay and working conditions.

The Mediterranean Sea is seriously overfished and heavily polluted with plastic. We are educating tomorrow's marine professionals and supporting efforts to lobby for environmental legislation.

The MSC Foundation has partnered with the IUCN in a three-year initiative to assess coral health and risks globally, applying IUCN's standards such as the Red List of Threatened Species™. We supported IUCN's global coral assessment, which evaluated 892 warm-water reef-building coral species and highlighted a rising risk, with nearly half now threatened. Together, we strive to enhance conservation efforts and deepen understanding of coral ecosystems worldwide.

Since 2011, we have helped Mercy Ships bring hope and healing to thousands of people without access to modern healthcare in Africa.
